Beagle Internet launches 3G Wireless Unleashed

Beagle Internet today announced the release of its 3G Wireless Broadband service which covers 96% of the Australian population using the Optus 3G wireless mobile broadband network.

With plans starting at just \$9.95 and a class-leading 5GB plan for \$37.95 per month, Beagle Internet is committed to providing cost effective Internet solutions. The service also comes with a back-up dial-up account for use in areas with limited or no coverage as well as standard product value-adds of five mailboxes with free anti-virus and anti-spam filtering, etc.

At just \$18.95 per month, the Unleashed 1GB plan is likely to attract a large number of existing dial-up and infrequent Internet users. As the Unleashed service requires no home or mobile telephone services, a customer's overall telecommunications spend is reduced when they switch.

Beagle Internet Business Development Manager Michael Mule noted "*With theoretical network speeds of up to 3.4Mbit/s and practical speeds achieved by our pilot users of 512kbit/s to 1.5Mbit/s, customers are able to derive significantly better value out of 3G wireless broadband than many other fixed line narrowband or broadband Internet products. The service obviously also has the added benefit that it is portable and perfect for renters or frequent travelers and unlike most other providers, comes with a back-up dial-up service.*"

As an incentive for existing Beagle customers to switch, Beagle is offering a free Huawei E160e USB wireless modem (worth \$179.95) and free activation (worth \$29.95) on a 24-month contract.

This offer is also extended to new customers until July 31, 2009.

In addition to this offering, Beagle Internet also provides a 0-month contract option that allows customers to bring their own Optus approved modem or purchase the equipment outright.
